Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

This is our privacy policy. It tells you how we collect and process data received from you on our site. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

2. Who We Are

Here are the details that the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regards to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, known as General Data Protection Regulation (**GDPR**) says we have to give you as a 'data controller':

3. What we may collect

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Your name, email address, telephone number, location and your preferred quiz venue
- Information you put into forms or surveys on our site at any time
- A record of any correspondence between us
- Financial data including bank account and payment card details

- Marketing and communication data including your preferences in receiving marketing from us
- We generally do not process special categories of data (sensitive data) and we will ask for your specific consent before processing any special categories of data

Under GDPR we will ensure that your personal data is processed lawfully, fairly, and transparently, without adversely affecting your rights. We will only process your personal data if at least one of the following basis applies:

- a) you have given consent to the processing of your personal data for one or more specific purposes;
- b) processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which you are a party or in order to take steps at the request of you prior to entering into a contract;
- c) processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which we are subject;
- d) processing is necessary to protect the vital interests of you or of another natural person;
- e) processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller; and/or
- f) processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by us or by a third party such as our credit card payment processing, except where such interests are overridden by the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject which require protection of personal data.

4.Cookies

We do not use cookies at present to capture any information from our users.

5.How we use what we collect

We use information about you to:

- Provide information, products and services that you request, or (with your consent) which we think may interest you
- Carry out our contracts with you
- [Allow you to use our interactive services if you want to]
- [Tell you our charges]

We may send out push notifications as a means to update our followers on the latest news and updates. You may deactivate push notifications on your device at any time.

In addition, if you don't want us to use your personal data for any of the other reasons set out in this section in 5, you can let us know at any time by contacting us at info@pubquiz.co.uk, and we will delete your data from our systems but we may have to keep certain information that we are obliged to retain. You acknowledge this may limit our ability to provide the best possible services to you.

In some cases, the collection of personal data may be a statutory or contractual requirement, and we will be limited in the products and services we can provide you if you don't provide your personal data in these cases.

6. Where we store your data

We may transfer your collected data to storage outside the European Economic Area (EEA). It may be processed outside the EEA to fulfil our services and to send you our marketing emails (if agree to receive them). By giving us your personal data, you agree to this arrangement.

We will do what we reasonably can to keep your data secure. Any data that you provide to us is stored on the MySQL database and also sent in an encrypted email to the administrator.

Although we try to provide protection, we cannot guarantee complete security for your data, and you take the risk that any sending of that data turns out to be not secure despite our efforts.

We only keep your personal data for as long as we need to in order to use it as described above in section 5, and/or for as long as we have your permission to keep it. In any event, we will conduct regular reviews to ascertain whether we need to keep your personal data. Your personal data will be deleted if we no longer need it and our general retention period is 60 months from the date of collection of your personal data.

7. Disclosing your information

We are allowed to disclose your information in the following cases:

- If we want to sell our business, or our company, we can disclose it to the potential buyer
- We can disclose it if we have a legal obligation to do so, or in order to protect other people's property, safety or rights

We do not routinely disclose your personal data to any third parties.

8. Your rights

You can ask us not to use your data for marketing. You can do this by ticking the relevant boxes on our forms, or by contacting us at any time at info@pubquiz.co.uk.

Under the GDPR, you have the right to:

- request access to, deletion of or correction of, your personal data held by us at no cost to you;
- request that your personal data be transferred to another person (data portability);
- be informed of what data processing is taking place;
- restrict processing;
- to object to processing of your personal data; and
- complain to a supervisory authority.

You also have rights with respect to automated decision-making and profiling as set out in section 11 below.
